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VITAL Program Components



Two Program Parts

Part 1: Tale Academy Modules Training (Asynchronous) – 42 hours (approximately)

- DATES TBD
- Three required modules of 8-10 sessions each
- Quizzes at the end of each session result in CTLE credits

Part 2: Train-the-Trainer Coaching (Synchronous) – 25-32 hours (approximately)

- DATES TBD
- Coaching sessions
- Development of Training Plan for Professional Learning Community or Regional Event

Part 1: TALE Academy Modules Training - 45-50 hours

All VITAL Educators complete Module 1: Shifting to Teaching Across Learning Environments (excluding microcredential activities) as a pre-requisite to continuation in the program.

Additionally:

- Each VITAL Educator will be assigned to complete a second module: Family and Community Engagement (Module 5) OR Leading to Support Educators (Module 7)
- Each VITAL Educator will be assigned one additional TALE Academy module, resulting in specialized trainer status:
 - Culturally Responsive and Sustaining Education Across Learning Environments (Module 2)
 - Meeting the Needs of Students with Disabilities Across Learning Environments (Module 3)
 - Meeting the Needs of English Language Learners Across Learning Environments (Module 4)
 - Social Emotional Learning Across Learning Environments (Module 6)







VITAL Educator Tasks – Part 1, Cont. DATES TBD

- Complete all sessions and activities for three modules
- Participate in one synchronous debrief session for each module (choice of three dates available per module).
- Complete Workbook Activities and Continuing Teacher Leader Education (CTLE) quizzes by:
 - 1st Module: DATES TBD
 - 2nd Module: DATES TBD
 - 3rd Module: DATES TBD
- Complete Artifacts/documentation (Microcredential Activities*) for two modules
- Contribute to Community Forum with comments/observations/ideas for fellow VITAL Educators.

Part 2: Train-the-Trainer Coaching - 25-32 hours

- Participate in synchronous "Coaching Support Sessions" for implementation support.
- Participate in individualized coaching sessions and wraparound supports.
- Complete a training plan for a small or large group training event.
- Provide feedback and input on virtual instruction in focus groups.

July 2024 – Program Completion

At the completion of the program:

- Each participant will receive a stipend of \$14,500.00 (after completion of all necessary assignments and paperwork)
- VITAL Educators receive a distinction of VITAL Trainer from NYSED
- VITAL Trainers will be listed on NYSED website as approved to deliver trainings based on the TALE Academy resources for at least five years





Program Completion (cont.)



While there will be no further financial opportunities from NYSED, it is expected that you are able to become a champion for the growth of virtual learning opportunities in New York

Teachers

- Offer to perform turnkey trainings in your district
- Become a member of your district's technology committee

Administrators

- Develop and/or expand virtual learning programs in school/district
- Utilize TALE resources to prepare teachers during a faculty meeting

Support Staff

- Coach teachers on ways to infuse SEL into virtual courses
- Ensure necessary supports are in place for virtualonly students in your school/district

Staff Developers

 Conduct regional or district-wide turnkey trainings using TALE Academy resources

Teacher Preparation Faculty

- Advocate for requiring preservice teachers to have preparation in virtual instruction
